<b>Entries:</b>	Entries will be accepted Monday, October 6 and Tuesday, October 7. A \$78 entry fee must accompany each entry. Please submit entries to Member Services, at the ARC. A maximum of 100 teams will be taken. Registration begins at 8:30am.
<b>Divisions</b>	Co-Rec
<b>Captains Meeting</b>	A mandatory captains' meeting will be held on October 9 at 8 p.m. in the ARC Auditorium. A team member must be in attendance.
<b>Captains Test</b>	All Captains' Tests are turned in to the ARC Member Services Desk by Friday, October 24, at Noon. <b>No Exceptions!</b>
<b>Schedules</b>	League schedules will be available on Friday, October 17 after 5 pm. They will be posted on our website at <a href="http://www.campusrec.uiuc.edu">www.campusrec.uiuc.edu</a> (IM Track). Games will be Monday's and Wednesday's starting at 6-11pm. Play will start October 20th.
<b>Types of Competition</b>	Teams will be in pools of five with one bye week. The top two teams in each pool will advance to a single elimination tournament. Please see the IM Handbook online for more information.
<b>Location &amp; Time</b>	All games will be played at ARC Gym 1.
<b>Eligibility</b>	A player can only play on ONE team for the duration of the league. Participants may not play on multiple teams within any division/league. Only current UIUC students who have paid the Student Service Fee and Campus Rec members are eligible to play. Please see the IM Handbook for more information.
<b>Rules</b>	Basketball rules are available on our website at <a href="http://www.campusrec.uiuc.edu">www.campusrec.uiuc.edu</a> .
<b>IDs</b>	Participants must present their current UIUC I-Card prior to each game. Participants not having his/her ID will not be allowed to participate.
<b>Awards</b>	Intramural Sports Champion t-shirts will be awarded to the first place team in each division.
<b>Refunds</b>	To receive an entry fee refund, minus a \$5 processing fee, teams must withdraw from the league before October 19.
<b>Miscellaneous</b>	Participants should be aware that there is a risk of injury in participation in intramural sports due to the inherent nature of activity. Individuals are encouraged to have a physical examination and obtain adequate health and accident insurance prior to participation. Individuals participate in Intramural sports at their own risk.

**All captains test are due back Friday, October 23 by Noon. If you fail the captain's test, you will be notified and ineligible for playoffs.**

1. What are rules regarding club sport member participation?
2. What forms of ID are acceptable for intramural participation? Can a participant use any other form other than the accepted form of ID?
3. If an individual arrives late are they able to participate? If so, what must they do to participate?
4. How much are forfeit fees, to whom are they assessed, and how can the fee be avoided?
5. Is jewelry allowed during intramural games?
6. What are acceptable things to protest? What are examples of protests that will not be upheld?
7. What happens if a team is caught playing with an ineligible player? What happens to the player who played illegally?
8. How does a team become, and stay, eligible for the playoffs?
9. If a team has a player ejected from a contest for unsportsmanlike conduct, what must the team/player do to become eligible to play again?
10. What are the uniform requirements for participation in intramural sports?

11. Under what circumstances can a player participate on more than one team in a sport?
12. If a player is ejected during an intramural volleyball game, will they be able to play in the basketball game the next night? What must they do?
13. How long are the halves? When does the clock stop?
14. How long is overtime, and when does the clock stop? How many timeouts do teams get when they go into overtime?
15. What is the mercy rule in intramural basketball?
16. What happens if a player receives two technical fouls? Will they be allowed to play in the team's next game?
17. A player from Team A leaves the team box area and approaches the scorer's table to check the score. What must now happen?
18. Team B has 4 players present to start the game. One player doesn't have an ID and another cannot remove his earring. Can this team start the game? Why/why not?
19. How many timeouts does each team have for the game? How many timeouts are awarded for the overtime periods?
20. What must happen if a player is found with blood on them or on their jersey?
