

Entries: Entries will be accepted Monday, September 29 and Tuesday, September 30. A \$78 entry fee must accompany each entry. Please submit entries to ARC Member Services. A maximum of 205 teams will be taken. (95 men, 80 frat, and 30 women) Registration begins at 8:30am.

Eligibility A player can only play on **ONE** team for the duration of the league. Participants may not play on multiple teams within any division/league. 1. What is the phone number for the Intramural Rainline?
2. What are rules regarding club sport member participation?
3. What forms of ID are acceptable for intramural participation?
4. If an individual arrives late are they able to participate? If so, what must they do to participate?
5. How much are forfeit fees, to whom are they assessed, and how can the fee be avoided?
6. Is jewelry allowed during intramural games?
7. What are acceptable things to protest? What are examples of protests that will not be upheld?
8. What is the process for protesting player eligibility? How many players can be called into question in a protest?
9. What happens if a team is caught playing with an ineligible player? What happens to the player who played illegally?

17. For a team to score a goal off of an indirect kick, what must happen first?

18. If a player is passed the ball behind the last defender on a throw-in and scores a goal, does the goal count? Why or why not?

19. The game is tied with :30 seconds left in the second half. A player from Team A is injured and is unable to continue playing. This causes Team A to fall below the minimum number of players needed, what happens?

20. After Team A scores a goal, the Team B goalie takes the ball, places it on the 18-yd. Line and kicks it off (Goal Kick). Is the legal way to restart play following a goal? If this is not legal, then explain the legal procedure.
